Curriculum Title - Invasion

Mathematics

Our multiplication check is in June so please keep practicing!

Our focus for our learning this term includes:

Fractions and Decimals as tenths and hundredths

Dividing a 1-digit and 2 -digit number by 10 and 100.

Comparing and ordering decimals

Writing money as decimals

Comparing and ordering amounts of money and solving word problems with money

Time – focus on the 24-hour clock

Shape – Angles, Triangles, Quadrilaterals and Symmetry

Position and Direction – plotting coordinates and translation

Art – Our project title is 'Islamic Art'. We will learn how to make geometric patterns and motifs on paper. **DT** – Our unit title is 'Tomb Builders'. We will learn about simple machines, including wheels, axles, inclined planes, pulleys and levers.

PE (subject to change)

PE will be twice a week on a Wednesday and Thursday. We will be outside as much as possible during the warmer weather. We will be learning skills in athletics, cricket and rounders. Please ensure your child has a water bottle on these days and a sun hat when the weather warms in the Summer months.

RE

Our syllabus promotes a multi-disciplinary study of religion and worldviews, developing children's knowledge and curiosity about the world in which they live.

Our two key questions this term are:

1. What does it mean to be a Hindu in Britain today?
2. How and why do people mark the significant events of life?



History

Our main focus this term is about Ancient Civilisations. We will think about how a civilisation is a developed society. We will learn about how they share common features, including cities, inventions, language, writing, hierarchy, leadership, infrastructure, arts and culture, trade and religion. The three civilisations we will be studying are: Ancient Sumer, Ancient Egyptians and the Indus Valley.



Computing

Our focus of learning will be based on a research activity and accessing information using the internet and multimedia resources. We will have a focus on safer internet use.

Music Chiranga scheme – we will be learning about Expression and Improvisation

MFL follows the Language Angels scheme – 'In the Classroom' and 'French Culture'.

English

Our first stimulus text is 'The Journey' by F. Sanna. We will be writing a refugee narrative. We will be thinking about how we can make predictions about a text and will look closely at drafting and writing by composing and rehearsing sentences orally, and then putting those into our extended independent writing lessons. Our second text is 'Manfish' by Jennifer Berne. We will be writing our own invention narratives. We will finish the term by writing a biography. We are having a real push on presentation and writing fluently. We have taught sessions during the week to support the independent expectation that all the children can write legibly and with a pen. Please ensure your children reads regularly at home and then they need to record their reading in their diary.

Science

We will be learning about electrical appliances and safety. We will construct simple series circuits and name their parts and functions, including switches, wires and cells. Our work will move onto investigating electrical conductors and insulators and identifying common features of conductors. We will learn about programmable devices. We will finish by combining our learning to design and make a nightlight.

Our theme this term is Health and Well-being
