The Agreement for the School

The School will do its best to:

- Ensure your child's physical and social well being at all times, and to foster feelings of confidence, self-worth and belonging

Agreement for Parents/Carers

To help my child at school, I will do my best to:

- Give my child every help with his/her schooling
- See that my child arrives at school, on time and is collected promptly at the end of the school day
- Contact the school before 9.15 a.m. on each day if my child is absent from school
- Ensure my child wears his/her school uniform and that it is clearly named
- Ensure my child brings the correct PE clothing and equipment for lessons
- Work with the school to try and ensure that my child behaves well and get in touch if there are any problems at home that may affect his/her health, work and behaviour
- Support my child with his/her home activities, and listen to my child read on a regular basis
- Support the school's behaviour policies and guidelines
- Attend parents' evenings
- Reply to any school correspondence
