How can parents help?

Encourage independence related to our ASPIRE values – Aspiration, Strength, Perseverance, Integrity, Responsibility and Empathy. For example, ask children to take responsibility for making their bed, helping with recycling, or support them to show empathy towards younger siblings. Record on WOW notes and send back in school.

Talk to your children and share photos about what it was like when you and other members of your family were at school.

Talk about likes, dislikes, daily routines, and key events.

Mathematics

Place Value – working within numbers within 20 and then within 100.

Addition and Subtraction within 20

Introduction to multiplication, division, money and fractions.

Position and direction.

PSHE – Health and Well Being

Thinking about Physical health and Mental wellbeing.

Learning how to keep healthy - food and exercise; hygiene routines; sun safety

PE – Tennis / Athletics

Developing running, jumping and throwing skills.

Developing throwing, catching and basic racket skills through a variety of fun games.

Art – Street View

Learning about artwork depicting streets and buildings.

Creating a 3-D mural based on Rizzi's work

DT – Food - Chop, Slice and Mash

Learning about sources of food and the preparatory skills of peeling, tearing, slicing, chopping, mashing and grating.

Learning about the use of technology, how to stay safe online and basic programming skills.



Science – Animal Parts / Plant Parts

Develop an understanding about animals, including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds, mammals and invertebrates.
